

The following notice is in substitution for that which appeared on page 4348 of the London Gazette dated 11th July, 1958:

PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934.

In pursuance of section 2 (3) of the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, the Minister of Power, hereby gives notice that in accordance with the provisions of that Act and of the Petroleum (Production) Regulations, 1935, as amended, he has granted a Methane Drainage Licence to the National Coal Board, details of which are given in the Schedule below. The boundaries are described from the one-inch Ordnance Survey Map.

Maps showing boundaries of the area may be inspected on application to the Ministry of Power, Petroleum Division, Thames House South, Millbank, London, S.W.1.

SCHEDULE.

An area of 1,360 square miles in the Counties of Lancaster, Chester, Flint, Denbigh and Salop in two parts generally rectangular and bounded approximately by the towns of Southport, Colne, Stockport and Widnes for the one part, and by Rhyl, Ellesmere Port and by points east and west of Oswestry for the other, the precise demarcations being straight lines between the following points:—

NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1952.

To:—JOHN DAVID McCOMB, Flying Tiger Line Inc., Municipal Airport, Cleveland, Ohio, U.S.A.

Pursuant to section 275 (5) of the Customs and Excise Act, 1952, and paragraph 1 of the 7th Schedule thereto, the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give you notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the customs and excise Acts and enactments amending those Acts, a "Fiat" motor car, engine number 044190, chassis number 041293, registration number 140-Z-1996 has been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds that the said car, being goods chargeable with a duty of customs, was imported at Southend, and was on 12th July, 1957, allowed to be delivered without payment of duty on condition that while in the United Kingdom the vehicle should not be sold or otherwise disposed of, should be used only by the importer and should not be used by any person principally resident in the United Kingdom, and that the said car should be

exported when the importer's temporary stay in the United Kingdom came to an end, which condition was not complied with. Whereby and by force of section 257 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1952, the said car is liable to forfeiture.

If you claim that the said car is not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in accordance with the said Schedule to the said Act specifying the name and address of a solicitor in England who is authorised to accept service of process and to act on your behalf. In default of such notice the said car will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeited and will be liable to be disposed of in such manner as the Commissioners of Customs and Excise may direct. If you make such claim within the time aforesaid, legal proceedings will be taken for the condemnation thereof.
