

Volkswagen motor car, registration number QG 7769, have been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds that the said vehicle was imported into the United Kingdom at Dover on or about the 22nd of May 1957, and being chargeable with a duty of Customs, was allowed to be delivered without payment of that duty on condition that it would be re-exported from the United Kingdom by the 28th November 1957, such condition being imposed by the Commissioners of Customs and Excise by virtue of Regulation 1 and Regulation 4 of the Private Vehicles (Temporary Importation) Regulations, 1952, and that the said condition was not observed, and that its non-observance was not sanctioned by the Commis-

sioners. Whereby and by force of section 257 of the said Act the said goods are liable to forfeiture.

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 3 of the 7th Schedule to the said Act, and in default of such notice the said goods will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeited and will be liable to be disposed of in such manner as the Commissioners of Customs and Excise may direct. If you make such claim within the time aforesaid, legal proceedings will be taken for the condemnation thereof.
