COUNTY BOROUGH OF WALLASEY

The Wallasey (Church Street) Smoke Control Order No. 1, 1958

1. Notice is hereby given that the Wallasey County Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above mentioned Act, on the 4th day of December 1958, made an Order entitled The Wallasey (Church Street) Smoke Control Order No. 1, 1958, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. By virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.
