contains provisions enabling a vehicle to wait upon the direction or with the permission of a polic constable in uniform or for so long as may be neces sary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruc-tion to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the road of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telegraph line.
