WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

Town and Country Planning (General Development) Order, 1950

Rural District of Horsham

Notice is hereby given that on the 29th day of December 1958, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed a Direction in pursuance of Article 4 of the above Order made by the County Council to the effect that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development in parts of the Rural District of Horsham, identified on the plan annexed to the direction of the description set out in the schedule hereto EXCEPT in the case of moveable structures or caravans used by travelling showmen in the course of their business.
