The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels case and electricity

fuels include antifractic, cone and office carbonate fuels, gas and electricity. 3. Copies of the said Orders and of the maps referred to therein, may be inspected free of charge at the Municipal Offices, High Wycombe at all reason-able times during the period of 6 weeks from the 4th March 1959 6th March 1959.

4. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Orders or any of them, may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Orders or any of them.
