Regulations made in pursuance of section 13 of the Architects (Registration) Act, 1931, amending the Existing Regulations.

### Schedule 2

Examinations recognised by the Council on the re-commendation of the Board of Architectural Educa-tion in accordance with section 6 (3) of the principal Act.

Amend Schedule 2 of the Regulations by the addition:

- (1) of the words "The Royal West of England Academy School of Architecture, Bristol, Diploma Final Examination, followed by the Examination in Professional Practice and Practical Experience."
  (2) of the words "The Department of Art and Architecture, Hammersmith College of Art and Building, Diploma Final Examination, followed by the Examination in Professional Practice and Practical Experience."
