### The Henley Rural District Council (Woodcote No. 15 Footpath) Diversion Order, 1959

The Order relates to land situate in the parish of Woodcote.

The effect of the Order will be to divert the public right of way running from the junction with Greenmoor Lane at point A as shown on the map annexed

to the Order in a north-westerly direction diagonally across O.S. No. 125 thence along the southern side of the northern boundary of O.S. No. 126 being part of the site of the Langtree Secondary School and thence in a north-westerly direction across O.S. No. 164 to the intersection with an allotment track running in a north-south direction at point D on the said map, being a total distance of 1262 feet or thereabouts, to a line running from the said point A in a westerly direction across O.S. No. 105 thence along the northern side of the southern boundary of the site of the said School and through O.S. No. 164 to point E on the said map and thence northward to the said point D, being a total distance of 1430 feet or thereabouts.

## RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL OF DARTFORD

### Diversion Order, 1959, No. 23

Notice is hereby given that on the 4th day of August 1959, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

The effect of this Order is:

(i) To create a public right-of-way on foot over land at Hulberry Farm in the parish of Eynsford from point "C" on C.R.F. 14 approximately 70 feet south east of the junction of footpath No. 20 with C.R.F. 14 leading in a south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 1,870 feet to point "D" on footpath No. 17 indicated on the map contained in the Order.

(ii) To extinguish as from the 14th October 1959, the public right-of-way commencing at point "A" at the junction of footpath No. 20 with C.R.F. 14 leading in a west south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 2,410 feet over Hulberry Farm, Eynsford to point "B" on footpath No. 17 indicated on the map contained in the Order.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order, as confirmed by the Minister, has been deposited at White Oak, Swanley, Kent, and will be open for inspection, free of charge, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on any weekday except Saturdays.

The Order becomes operative as from the 14th day of August 1959, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in
