To substitute the following for Article 3 of the Blackpool (Promenade) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1958:

Save as provided in Article 7 of that Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.0 a.m. and 6.0 p.m. and between the Saturday before Whit Monday and the last Monday but one in October (both days inclusive) in each and every year on the east side of that length of the Promenade Carriage Drive (Route A.584) which lies between its junction with Cocker Square and its junction with Talbot Square for a longer period than thirty minutes or if a period of less than thirty minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on that side of the Promenade Carriage Drive.
