INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS (IMMUNITIES AND PRIVILEGES) ACT, 1950

In pursuance of subsection (1) (c) of section 2 of the International Organisations (Immunities and Privileges) Act, 1950 (14 Geo. 6, Chapter 14), Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs hereby gives notice of the following amendments to the list published in the *London Gazette* of 29th November 1957 as amended by notices published on 17th January 1958, 21st February 1958, 29th April 1958, 30th June 1958, 31st October 1958, 8th May 1959 and 29th May 1959, of persons who are entitled to immunities and privileges conferred by the International Organisations (Immunities and Privileges of the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation) Order, 1954. These amendments shall take effect in relation to each person from the date specified after his name, being the date as from which, for the purposes of the said Order in Council, such person first held or ceased to hold the office or employment in question:
