## FACTORIES ACT, 1937 TO 1959

The Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that on 10th December 1959 he made The Sunday Baking and Sausage Making (Christmas and New Year) Order, 1959 as a special exemption Order under section 23 of the Factories Act, 1959. This Order enables women who have attained the age of eighteen to be employed on Sunday, 20th December 1959 in England and Wales in the manufacture of bread or flour confectionery (including meat and fruit pies but not biscuits) or sausages, and on Sunday, 27th December 1959, in Scotland, in the manufacture of meat pies or sausages.
