In June 1959, six live torpedoes were discovered in the fore end of a sunken Japanese submarine after the bows had broken away from the main portion during salvage operations in Singapore Roads. The torpedoes constituted a menace which could only be eliminated by removing them in their tubes for dumping in deep water.

Lieutenant Messervy was placed in charge of this task which involved prolonged underwater cutting with a flame cutter within a few inches of two and a half tons of explosive in the warheads with detonators and primers alive. Added to these hazards were those of working underwater in a mass of wreckage, without plans of the submarine, the instability of which in prevailing adverse conditions of sea and tide made any diving operation highly dangerous.

Lieutenant Messervy was invariably the first to undertake each hazardous phase of the operation, and carried out most of the dangerous work personally, thereby minimising the risk to the rest of the team. He showed an exceptional degree of sustained courage in the face of danger.
