PRIVY COUNCIL OFFICE

PRESENT,

The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 11th day of December 1959, in the words and figures following, that is to say:

"We, the Church Commissioners, acting in pursuance of the Pastoral Reorganisation Measure, 1949, and the Union of Benefices Measures, 1923 to 1952, now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme which we have prepared with the consent of the Right Reverend William, Bishop of Manchester (in testimony whereof he has signed this Scheme), for effecting the union of the benefice of All Saints, Chorlton-on-Medlock, the benefice of Holy Trinity, Hulme, the benefice of Saint John the Baptist, Hulme, and the benefice of Saint Philip, Hulme, all situate in the diocese of Manchester.

"SCHEME

"1. *Union of Benefices and Parishes.* The benefice of All Saints, Chorlton-on-Medlock, the benefice of Holy Trinity, Hulme, the benefice of Saint John the Baptist, Hulme, and the benefice of Saint Philip, Hulme, shall be permanently united together and form one benefice with cure of souls under the style of 'The United Benefice of Saint Philip, Hulme' and the parishes of the said benefices shall also be united into one parish for ecclesiastical purposes.

"2. *Taking effect of union.* Upon the day when any Order of Your Majesty in Council affirming this Scheme is published in the *London Gazette* the union shall forthwith take effect and the Reverend Gordon Frederick Dowden if he is then incumbent of the said benefice of Saint Philip, Hulme, shall, with his consent (which has been given to us in writing), be the first incumbent of the united benefice.

"3. *Parish Church.* The parish church of the parish of Saint Philip, Hulme, shall be the parish church of the united parish.

"4. *Parsonage House.* Without prejudice to the exercise before the date when the union takes effect
