PRESENT,

The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 28th day of January 1960, in the words and figures following, that is to say:

"We, the Church Commissioners, acting in pursuance of the New Parishes Measure, 1943, have prepared and humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for constituting a new parish to be taken out of the parish of Saint John, Mansfield, in the diocese of Southwell.

" SCHEME

"Whereas we, the Church Commissioners, are satisfied that the spiritual interests of the area defined in the subjoined Schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed would be best served by constituting it a new parish:

"And whereas we are satisfied that a suitable endowment thereof will be provided:

"And whereas there is within the said area a consecrated church known as Saint Mary which has been approved by us, the said Church Commissioners, as suitable to be the parish church of the new parish and of which the patronage belongs to the Bishop of Southwell by virtue of an agreement in writing dated the 30th day of May 1957, and made pursuant to section 9 of the New Parishes Measure, 1943:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Russell, Bishop of Southwell, (in testimony whereof he has executed this Scheme), we, the said Church Commissioners, do humbly recommend and propose as follows, that is to say:

" 1. Constitution.

"(a) As from the day of the date of the publication in the *London Gazette* of any Order of Your Majesty in Council confirming this Scheme, the area defined in the subjoined Schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed shall be a new parish.

"(b) The Church of Saint Mary aforesaid shall be the parish church of the parish.

"(c) The name of the parish shall be 'The Parish of Saint Mary, Ladybrook'.

" 2. Archdeaconry and Rural Deanery.

"The parish shall be in the Archdeaconry of Newark and in the rural deanery of Mansfield.

" THE SCHEDULE

"The area comprising:

"All that part (coloured pink on the map annexed hereto) of the parish of Saint John, Mansfield, which lies to the southwest of an imaginary line commencing at the point on the boundary between the parishes of Saint Mark, Mansfield, and Saint John, Mansfield, opposite the middle of Bancroft Lane and proceeding thence northwards to and along the middle of the last mentioned lane to the point opposite the middle of Oakdale Road thence northwards to and along the middle of the last mentioned road to its end and in the same straight line to the middle of Ladybrook Lane thence westwards along the middle of Ladybrook Lane to the point opposite the middle of the south-eastern end of Harrop White Road thence northwards to and northwards and northwards along the middle of the last mentioned road to its end and in the same straight line to the middle
