*The Market Bosworth Rural District Council
(Higham-on-the-Hill) Public Paths Extinguishment
Order, 1960*

The above Order made on the 16th day of March 1960, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to extinguish the public rights of way at Higham-on-the-Hill—(a) running from Station Road opposite Railway Bridge No. 8 in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 77 yards; (b) running from Station Road near the south-east corner of Field O.S. No. 304 in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 207 yards; (c) running from the north-western side of Field O.S. No. 235 in a generally north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 150 yards; and (d) running from near the northern corner of Field O.S. No. 261 in a generally northerly direction for a distance of 40 yards.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Rural District Council Offices, Market Bosworth, between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on weekdays (10 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturdays).

Any objection or representation concerning the Order may be sent in writing to the Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before the 6th day of May 1960, and should state the grounds on which it is made.

River Severn Scheme
