Chapel Street, Marlow—Both sides, from the junction with Spittal Square north eastwards to the boundary between Nos. 29 and 31 Chapel Street.

Dean Street, Marlow—Both sides, from the junction with Spittal Square north westwards to a point approximately 5 yards north west of the southern boundary of Markow Police Station.

Spittal Square

West side. From its junction with Spittal Street to its junction with Dean Street.

Northeast side From its junction with Dean Street to its junction with Chapel Street.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from a vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition the removal of any obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.
