Any owner or occupier of any land to which the Order relates may send to Basildon Development Corporation at the address below, a request in writing to serve him with a notice that the Order has been confirmed, and naming the place where a copy of the Order and of the Map and of any descriptive matter annexed thereto, may be seen.
