WETHERBY RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Wetherby Rural (Wigton Moor) Smoke Control Order, 1960

1. Notice is hereby given that the Wetherby Rural District Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 8th day of September 1960, made an Order entitled "The Wetherby Rural (Wigton Moor) Smoke Control Order, 1960" declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Colonial Offices, Wetherby, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 26th day of September 1960.

4. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Bedfordshire County Council (Market Square and North Street, Leighton Buzzard) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1960.

The Bedfordshire County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. in the following lengths of roads:

- (a) That length of Market Square (north side only) and North Street (west side only) from the eastern boundary of the premises known as No. 1 Market Square for a distance of 150 yards in a north-easterly direction;
- (b) That length of Market Square (south side only of the northern carriageway) from the western end of the Cross Keys Public House for a distance of 35 yards in a north-easterly direction to the western end of No. 29A Market Square;

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the said lengths of roads above referred to or the services therein.

JARROW BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Jarrow (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1960

On the 8th September 1960, the Jarrow Borough Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, any vehicle waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in any of the following lengths of roads:

1. That length of Bede Burn Road from its junction with Surrey Street to its junction with Albert Road;
2. The whole length of Albert Road from the Jarrow/Hebburn boundary to its junction with High Street;
3. The whole length of High Street from its junction with Albert Road to its junction with Short Row;

Nothing in the Order prevents any person from permitting a vehicle to wait in order to pick up or discharge passengers, load or unload goods, or to carry out necessary repair work to any building, roadway, or public utility undertaking's apparatus, or to prevent any vehicle from refuelling.

The Borough of Torquay (Tor Church Road) (One-Way) Order, 1960
