The High Wycombe and Wycombe Rural (Plomer Hill Farm Estate) Smoke Control Area Order, 1961.

1. Notice is hereby given that the High Wycombe Borough Council and the Wycombe Rural District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 19th day of July 1960 and the 27th day of July 1959, respectively, made an Order entitled "The High Wycombe and Wycombe Rural (Plomer Hill Farm Estate) Smoke Control Area Order 1961" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. By virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. Copies of the said Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Municipal Offices, High Wycombe and at 17 High Street, High Wycombe, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 30th September 1960.

4. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
