HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

Borough of Reigate (Footpath No. 17, Clayhall Farm) Public Path Extinguishment Order, 1960

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by section 112 of the above Act, after consultation with the Reigate Borough Council proposes to make an Order for the extinguishment of part of Footpath No. 17, South Park, Reigate, in the Borough of Reigate in the County of Surrey.

Its effect will be to extinguish part of the public right of way leading from Clayhall Lane to Littleton Lane, Reigate, which part commences at a point on the northern boundary of Clayhall Lane opposite Clayhall Farm, and leads in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 288 yards to its junction with public footpath No. 58 at a point approximately 170 yards south of Ede's Cottages.

A copy of the draft Order and of the map contained therein has been deposited at the Town Hall, Reigate, Surrey, and at the Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, and will be open for inspection free of charge during normal office hours.
