The above Order made on the 28th day of October 1960, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to extinguish the following public right of way:

(1) The public right of way commencing at its junction with the road leading from Northwick to Elberton at the Northern boundary of O.S. plot No. 27 on the Ordnance Survey Map for the Parish of Olveston in the county of Gloucester (1921 Edition) at a point South of Manor Farm extending for a distance of approximately 818 yards in a general easterly direction through the fields numbered 24, 18, 16, 15 and 11 on the said Ordnance Survey Map to the point of its junction with the path described in (2) below at the Eastern boundary of field No. 12 on the said Ordnance Survey Map.

(2) The public right of way commencing from the North Eastern corner of field No. 31 on the said Ordnance Survey Map at its junction with the road leading from Northwick to Elberton extending for a distance of approximately 340 yards in a general Southerly direction and thence for a distance of approximately 283 yards in a general easterly direction following the course of a lane to the north western corner of field No. 73 on the said Ordnance Survey Map, thence for a distance of approximately 420 yards in a general south easterly direction to the south eastern boundary of field No. 64 on the said Ordnance Survey Map, thence for a distance of approximately 90 yards along the south eastern boundaries of the said field No. 64, and field No. 65, thence for a distance of approximately 217 yards to a point near the North Eastern corner of the said field No. 65 on the said Ordnance Survey Map and thence for a distance of 150 yards in a north westerly direction along a lane to the point where it rejoins the road leading from Northwick to Elberton near the North Eastern corner of the field No. 12 on the said Ordnance Survey Map.
