WAGES COUNCILS ACT, 1959

Hollow-ware Wages Council (Great Britain)

Town and Country Planning Act, 1947

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 49 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Lancaster) (No. 26) Order, 1960," authorising the stopping up of a length of footpath No. 31 at Beacon Road, Billinge, near Wigan, Lancashire, and requiring the provision of a new footpath and the widening of Beacon Road.
