

4. Details of the restrictions referred to in (b) above will be given on signs erected on the pavement.

5. The Regulations will come into force on 28th November 1960, and will remain in force for an experimental period of up to six months.

ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 TO 1953

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Works (hereinafter called "the Minister") in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 11 of the Historic Buildings and Ancient Monuments Act, 1953, on 7th November 1960, made a Preservation Order entitled "The Wingfield Manor Preservation Order, 1960," placing the ancient monument consisting of parts of Wingfield Manor in the Parish of South Wingfield in the County of Derby (in respect of which an Interim Preservation Notice under section 10 of the said Act has been in force) under his more lasting protection.

The Order is not subject to special parliamentary procedure.

A copy of the Order as made by the Minister and of the plan annexed thereto may be inspected during usual office hours at the Ministry of Works (A.S.22), Lambeth Bridge House, London S.E.1, or at the offices of the Belper Rural District Council, Chesterfield Road, Belper, Derbyshire.

The Order as made becomes operative on the date on which this notice is first published, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof on the ground that any requirement of the said Historic Buildings and Ancient Monuments Act, 1953, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order becomes operative, make an application to the High Court and on any such application the Court, if satisfied that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any such requirement, may quash the Order or any provision contained therein.
