BOROUGH OF HALESOWEN

*The Borough of Halesowen Highfields No. 1
Smoke Control Order, 1960*

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Halesowen in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 7th day of November 1960 made an Order entitled the Borough of Halesowen Highfields

No. 1 Smoke Control Order, 1960, declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of October 1961, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

4. Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Great Cornbow, Halesowen at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 19th day of November 1960.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

That part of the Borough of Halesowen containing an area of 2.6 acres and bounded on the south side by the centre-line of Highfields Lane (from a point 47 yards west of its junction with Hagley Road to its junction with Andrew Road) on the west side by the centre-line of Andrew Road (from its junction with Highfields Lane to its junction with Queensway) on the north side by the centre-line of Queensway (from its junction with Andrew Road to a point 52 yards west of its junction with Hagley Road) and on the east side by a line running from the said point 52 yards west of the junction of Queensway with Hagley Road along the eastern boundary of the Corporation's flats and maisonettes fronting Andrew Road and Queensway to a point 47 yards west of the junction of Highfields Lane with Hagley Road.
