The authorised fuels include Anthracite, 'Coke and other carbonised' fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st October 1961, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

4. (Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town [Hall, Wood Green, London N.22, at all reason-able times during the period of six weeks from the 7th day of January 1961.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
