EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

- This Order amends the Order of the 29th September, 1949, as amended by subsequent Orders.
- The maximum rate of education allowances for children is increased from £80 a year to £120 a year. (Articles 2 and 17.)
- The normal maximum rate of an allowance payable for constant attendance is increased from £100 a year to £104 a year in the case of officers and from 35s. a week to 40s. a week in the case of ratings, and the maximum rate for exceptional cases of very severe disablement is increased from £182 a year to £208 a year in the case of officers and from 70s. a week to 80s. a week in the case of ratings. (Article 3.)
