HALIFAX COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Halifax (No. 4) Smoke Control Order, 1961

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Halifax in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 111 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 4th day of January 1961, made an Order entitled *The Halifax (No. 4) Smoke Control Order, 1961*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 111 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emissions of smoke were not caused by the use of fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st October 1961, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

4. Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Halifax, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 13th day of January 1961.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The Smoke Control Area No. 4, comprises an area bounded on the North by Fountain Street, Wards End and Horton Street, on the east by Union Street South, Hunger Hill, Shay Syke and the western embankment of the railway line, on the south by Haigh Lane, Drycough Lane and Skircoat Moor Road, and on the west by Savile Park, Savile Park Road and Bull Close Lane, and is shown surrounded with a green line on the map of the area.

that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels, include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of November 1961, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

4. Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Department in the Council House at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 17th day of January 1961.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

An area of approximately 153 acres bounded by Shenley Lane, Shenley Hill, Merritts Hill, Genners Lane, Moors Lane, Cromwell Lane and Woodcock Lane to the junction with Shenley Lane.
