- (ii) if a period of less than thirty minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle.
- (b) in any of the following lengths of road:
   (l) That length of Kings Saltern Road,
   Lymington, which lies between its junction with Bath Road and its junction with Stanley
  - (2) That length of Bath Road which lies between its junction with Kings Saltern Road and a point 50-feet north west of that junction;
  - (3) On the north east side of Bath Road between a point 50-feet from its junction with Kings Saltern Road and its junction with Solent Avenue:
  - (4) That length of the south west side of Bath Road which lies between its junction with Solent Avenue and a point 20-feet south east of that junction.
