ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY COUNCIL

Pier Street and Battery Slipway, Sandown  
"No Waiting" Order

The Isle of Wight County Council propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit, subject to the usual exemptions, the waiting of any vehicle from the 1st June to the 30th September in any year in the following lengths of road:

- (a) Pier Street, Sandown, between High Street and Battery Slipway;
- (b) Battery Slipway, between Pier Street and Sandown Esplanade.

Extension of Speed Limit at Caistor

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey, intend to make application to the Minister of Transport for his consent to the making of an Order, the effect of which will be that the following length of road shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 19 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960:
