The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas there was this day read at the Board a Memorial from the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, dated the 31st day of May 1961 (N.P. 1915/60) in the words following, viz.:—

"Whereas by Section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act, 1865, it is enacted, inter alia, that all pay, pensions or other allowances in the nature thereof payable in respect of services in Your Majesty's Naval or Marine Force to a person being or having been an Officer, Seaman or Marine therein, shall be paid in such manner and subject to such restrictions, conditions and provisions as are from time to time directed by Order in Council:

"And whereas in Schedule IV of Order in Council dated the 19th October 1954, provision is made for the payment of permanent commission grants of £1,500 (taxable) and £1,250 (taxable) to Medical and Dental Officers of the Royal Navy respectively transferred to permanent commissions:

"And whereas by Order in Council dated the 28th January 1958, provision is made for Medical and Dental Officers of the Royal Navy and when appropriate of the Royal Naval Reserve appointable as Senior Specialists or as Specialists to be paid allowances at the rates of 12s. 0d. and 4s. 0d. a day respectively:

"And whereas in Schedule II of Order in Council dated the 3rd August 1960, certain rates of pay were laid down for Medical and Dental Officers of the Royal Navy and in certain circumstances of the Royal Naval Reserve:

"And whereas we consider that the rates of pay prescribed for Medical and Dental Officers up to and

including the ranks of Surgeon Captain and Surgeon Captain (D) should be increased; that the rates of pay and permanent commission grants for Medical and Dental Officers should be the same; and that the rates of allowance payable to those appointable as Senior Specialists or Specialists should be increased:

"We beg leave humbly to recommend that Your Majesty may be graciously pleased by Your Order in Council to sanction with effect from 1st April 1960, the rates of pay, specialist pay and permanent commission grants contained in the accompanying Schedule; the rates of pay being in substitution for those previously authorised:

"The Lords Commissioners of Your Majesty's Treasury have signified their concurrence in these proposals:
