Schedule 2

Examinations recognised by the Council on the recommendation of the Board of Architectural Education in accordance with section 6 (3) of the principal Act.

Amend Schedule 2 of the Regulations by altering the reference to the School of Architecture, College of Art, Leicester, to read "The School of Architecture, College of Art, Leicester: Diploma Final Examination or Certificate Final Examination held at the end of the seven years composite course, followed in either case by the Examination in Professional Practice and Practical Experience."
