

*Highways Act, 1959**Margaretting By-Pass and Side Roads*

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. An Order under section 7 of the above Act providing:

- (a) that a road which he proposed to construct at Margaretting in the County of Essex shall become a trunk road on the date when the Order comes into operation and
- (b) that the length of the London—Great Yarmouth Trunk Road to be superseded shall cease to be a trunk road on the 1st April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Essex County Council (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the new Trunk Road is opened for through traffic.

2. An Order under section 9 of the above Act providing:

- (a) for the re-alignment and regrading of a length of Penny's Lane and two lengths of Wantz Road,
- (b) for the construction by the Minister of 4 new highways,
- (c) authority for the stopping up of a length of Wantz Road,
- (d) that Essex County Council shall become the highway authority for the new highways on the first day of April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Council that the new roads are open for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Orders and of the relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 8th December 1961, to 8th March 1962, at the offices of the Ministry of Transport, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1; the County Council of Essex, County Offices, Chelmsford; and the Divisional Road Engineer, Palace Chambers, Silver Street, Bedford.

Any person may within three months from 8th December 1961, object to the making of the Orders by notice to the Minister quoting HA 104/12/06 and stating the grounds of objection.

*Highways Act, 1959**Brent Cross Flyover*

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. An Order under section 7 of the above Act providing—

- (a) that a highway which he proposes to construct at Brent Cross, Hendon, in the County of Middlesex, shall become a trunk road on the date when the Order comes into operation; and
- (b) that the length of the London—Carlisle—Glasgow—Inverness Trunk Road to be superseded shall cease to be a trunk road on the first day of April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Borough Council of Hendon (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the new highway is opened for through traffic.

2. An Order under section 9 of the above Act providing—

- (a) for the construction by the Minister of a new road at Brent Cross, Hendon, in the County of Middlesex;
- (b) authority for the stopping up of the superseded trunk road at its southern junction with the London North Circular Road;
- (c) that the Borough Council of Hendon shall become the highway authority for the new road on the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Council that the new road is opened for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Orders and of the relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 8th December 1961, to 8th March 1962, at the offices of the Ministry of Transport, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, The County Council of Middlesex, Guildhall, Westminster, London S.W.1, and of the Borough Council of Hendon, Town Hall, Hendon, London N.W.4.

Any person may within three months from 8th December 1961, object to the making of the Order by notice to the Minister quoting reference HT 41/25/01 and stating the grounds of objection.
