THE HALIFAX COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

County Borough of Halifax Development Plan

Notice is hereby given that proposals for alterations and additions to the above Development Plan were on the 7th day of December 1961, submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

The proposals relate to land situate within the County Borough of Halifax (a) being land within an area bounded by Cow Green, Lister Lane, Sunderland's Yard, Duke Street, Mount Street, Back Street and Swine Market, (b) land abutting on Chapeltown, (c) land abutting on Swine Market, Gibbet Street and Dungeon Street, and (d) land consisting of Numbers 60, 62, 64 and 66 Crown Street, Halifax.

BRIDGWATER RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Bridgwater Rural District Council (Spaxton) Public Path Diversion Order, 1961

HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Hampshire (Petersfield Rural District No. 22) (Parish of Buriton—Path No. 24) Public Path Diversion Order, 1961.

On the 30th day of November 1961, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

Its effect will be to divert the public right of way in the Parish of: Buriton, running in a westerly direction from the eastern verge of arable field O.S. Parcel No. 351 across arable fields O.S. Parcel Nos. 351, 254, and 255 to the south-west corner of O.S. Parcel No. 255 at Pitcroft Lane, a distance of approximately 734 yards; to a route running from the eastern verge of arable field O.S. Parcel No. 251 running northwards along the eastern edge of field westwards along the northern verges of arable field O.S. Parcel Nos. 351, 254 and 255 following the eastern and southern sides of Cowhouse Farm and thence south westwards across O.S. Parcel No. 257 to its south-west corner with Pitcroft Lane, a distance of approximately 967 yards. (Hants Sheet LX.8, 1932 Edition and Hants Sheet LXI.9, 1909 Edition).

The Order becomes operative as from the day of publication of this notice, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may, within six weeks from the date of publication of the notice, make application to the High Court.
