The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 49 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (City and County Borough of Leeds) (No. 2) Order, 1962" authorising the stopping up of Silver Street at Beeston, Leeds 11.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of the 6th February 1962, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

*The Trunk Road (Stretton on Dunsmore) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1962*

On the 16th January 1962, the Minister of Transport made the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, which will come into operation on the 6th February 1962.

The effect of the Order is that with certain exceptions, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in that length of the London—Holyhead Trunk Road (A.45) in the Parish of Stretton on Dunsmore in the County of Warwick, which lies between its junction with the Fosse Way and a point 690 yards east of that junction.

*The Trunk Road (Penkridge) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order*

The Minister of Transport proposes to make an Order under sections 26 and 28 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be that:

1. The County of Stafford (Penkridge) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1956, which prohibited waiting between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on the west side of that length of the Worcester—Wolverhampton—South of Stafford Trunk Road in the Parish of Penkridge which lies between a point 25 yards north of its junction with Pinfold Lane and a point 170 yards south of its junction with St. Michael's Square, shall be revoked; and
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. in the length or on the side of the Worcester—Wolverhampton—South of Stafford Trunk Road (A.449) in the Parish of Penkridge in the County of Stafford specified in the Schedule hereto.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demoli-

tion, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.
