East Suffolk and Norfolk River Board
Holme Common Internal Drainage District

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food has now confirmed the Order made on the 25th January 1962, confirming the Scheme submitted by the East Suffolk and Norfolk River Board under section 4 (1) (b) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, as applied by the River Boards Act, 1948, making provision for the following matters:

- (i) The Constitution of the Holme Common Internal Drainage District and the Holme Common Internal Drainage Board.
(ii) Matters supplemental to or consequential thereon.

(iii) The revocation of certain provisions of an Award.

The Scheme affects lands in the Parishes of Holme-next-the-Sea and Thornham.

A copy of the Order may be seen at all reasonable hours at the office of the Clerk of the East Suffolk and Norfolk River Board, The Cedars, Albemarle Road, Norwich, and at the offices of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London S.W.1.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the Land Drainage Act, 1930, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.

WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT, 1949

To All Holders of Aircraft Licences

The Postmaster General hereby gives notice that with effect from the date of this notice the terms, provisions and limitations of all Wireless Telegraphy Licences of the class and under the title stated above and granted by him on or before 22nd day of November 1961, shall be varied as follows:

Delete Clause 2 (4) and substitute:

This Licence together with any notices of variation served on the Licensee in writing by virtue of the provisions of Clause 4 (3) of this Licence shall be available for inspection when required by any person acting in the course of his duty on behalf of the Postmaster General or the Minister of Aviation and by competent authorities of the countries where the aircraft calls.

To All Holders of Aeronautical Ground Station Licences (Ministry of Supply Contractors Form)

In the title of the licence and clauses 1 (2) (b), 3, 5, 7 and in the notes delete the word "Supply" and substitute "Aviation".
