PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

SCUNTHORPE BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Scunthorpe Smoke Control Order, No. 1, 1959 (Variation) Order, 1962

Notice is hereby given that the Scunthorpe Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 (5) of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 28th day of February 1962, made an Order entitled the Borough of Scunthorpe Smoke Control Order No. 1, 1959 (Variation) Order, 1962, affecting the area described in the Schedule hereto, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

On any day after the Order has come into operation it shall be permissible to use kindling sticks and paper in fireplaces in buildings or parts of buildings, separately occupied without gas supply, upon condition that only authorised fuels, as declared by regulations under the Clean Air Act, 1956, shall be used in the fireplaces.

Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge at the Public Health Department, High Street East, Scunthorpe, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 23rd day of March 1962.

Within the said period any person who will be

affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

THE SCHEDULE

All that area of land bounded on the north by the south side of Burringham Road on the east by the west side of Messingham Road on the south side by the Borough Boundary and on the west by the east side of Scotter Road.

TROWBRIDGE URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Trowbridge (Off Street Car Parks) (No. 1) Order, 1962

The Trowbridge (Street Parking Places) (No. 1) Order, 1962

The Trowbridge Urban District Council propose to make Orders under section 81 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, sub-section 2 of section 11 and sub-section 1 of section 16 of the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1961, the effect of which will be to restrict the waiting periods for vehicles in existing Parking Places in Fore Street, Roundstone Street, Church Street, Court Street, Bythesea Road and Union Street and in the Off Street Car Parks at The Parade, St. Stephens Place, Back Street, Upper Broad Street, Broad Street, Longfield Road, Bythesea Road, Church Street, Town Bridge, Market Yard and Congre Parking Places between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on weekdays.
