At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 28th day of March 1962.

Present,

The QUEEN'S most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas there was this day read at the Board a Memorial from the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, dated the 22nd day of March 1962 (N.P. 1226/62) in the words following, viz:—

"Whereas by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act, 1865, it is enacted, *inter alia*, that all pay, pensions or other allowances in the nature thereof, payable in respect of services in Your Majesty's Naval or Marine Force to a person being or having been an Officer, Seaman or Marine therein, shall be paid in such manner and subject to such restrictions, conditions and provisions as are from time to time directed by Order in Council;

"And whereas under various Orders in Council, rates and conditions of award of retired pay, pensions, terminal grants and gratuities have been laid down

for Officers, Petty Officers, Non-Commissioned Officers and Men of Your Majesty's Royal Navy and Royal Marines; for Officers and Ratings of the Women's Royal Naval Service; and for members of Queen Alexandra's Royal Naval Nursing Service of the rank of Nursing Sister and above;

"And whereas by Order in Council (No. 64*/N.P.) dated 24th March, 1961, revised service retired pay and pensions regulations were introduced;

"And whereas by Order in Council (No. 53*/N.P.) dated 12th September 1960, revised scales and conditions were laid down for the award of pensions and gratuities to the widows and children of deceased Officers.

"And whereas we deem it expedient that revised scales of service retired pay and pensions should be introduced and that certain other changes should be made in the aforesaid regulations;

"We beg humbly to recommend that Your Majesty may be graciously pleased by Your Order in Council to sanction the regulations and amendments set forth in the Schedules annexed hereto.

"The Lords Commissioners of Your Majesty's Treasury have signified Their concurrence in these proposals.

" SCHEDULE I

" SERVICE RETIRED PAY AND TERMINAL GRANTS FOR PERMANENT ROYAL NAVY AND ROYAL MARINE OFFICERS

"1. Officers as defined in Clause 2 of Order in Council (No. 64*/N.P.) of 24th March, 1961, Schedule I, Section II, who are retired compulsorily for age or non-employment on or after 1st February, 1962, may be granted retired pay at the rates set out in Clause 2 hereunder with effect from 1st April, 1962, and at the rates set out in Clause 3 with effect from 1st April, 1963. Awards in respect of retirement on other grounds and under other conditions to be as provided in Clauses 6 to 14 of Section II, and in Sections VI and VIII, of Schedule I of Order in Council (No. 64*/N.P.) of 24th March, 1961, relative to the rates set out in Clauses 2 and 3 hereunder, and, in respect of reversion to the Retired List on or after 1st February, 1962, following re-employment, to Clause 5 hereunder.

"2. The rates of retired pay effective from 1st April, 1962, to be as follows:—

"(a) General List, Medical, Dental and Instructor Officers and certain Special Duties List Officers.
