COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949

*Forest of Bowland Areas of Outstanding Natural
Beauty (Designation) Order, 196*

Notice is hereby given that the National Parks Commission propose to make and submit to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation the above-mentioned Order.

The effect of the proposed Order, which will not come into operation until confirmed by the Minister of Housing and Local Government, will be to constitute the land to which the proposed Order relates areas of outstanding natural beauty for the purposes of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949.

The proposed Order relates to land situated in the County of Lancaster and in the West Riding of the County of York and comprises land within the under-mentioned districts:
