*Road Traffic Act, 1960**Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1960*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport has made "The Parking Places (Kingston-upon-Thames) (No. 1) Order 1962" (S.I. 1962 No. 1426) which designates parking places on certain highways in the Royal Borough of Kingston-upon-Thames at which charges may be made by the Council of that Borough for vehicles authorised by the Order to be left in those parking places. The Order specifies the amount of these charges and the periods for which vehicles may be left in the parking places. Provision is made in the Order for the Council to install parking meters on or in the vicinity of parking places and to carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of the parking places.
