COUNCIL*The Metropolitan Borough of Battersea (No. 3)
Smoke Control Order, 1962*

Notice is hereby given that the Battersea Metropolitan Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 20th day of June 1962, made an Order entitled the Metropolitan Borough of Battersea (No. 3) Smoke Control Order, 1962, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Clean Air Act, 1956, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Lavender Hill, Battersea, London, S.W.11, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 20th day of July 1962.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The area is approximately 291 acres and is bounded by Broomwood Road (even numbers) on the south, Battersea Rise (odd numbers) and Clapham Common North Side on the north and the borough boundaries on Wandsworth Common on the west and Clapham Common on the east.

The boundary of the area is defined and is shown more particularly by the map referred to in the Order.

PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL

The Portsmouth (Traffic Regulation) (One Way Streets) (No. 8) Order, 1962

On 10th July 1962, the Portsmouth City Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of any vehicle along the under-mentioned roads otherwise than in the direction stated:

Length of Road	Direction
Somers Road North, between its junction with the east side of Besant Road and its junction with the west side of Fratton Road.	Westward
Fratton Grove, between its junction with the east side of Vivash Road and its junction with the west side of Fratton Road.	Eastward

PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL

The Portsmouth (Traffic Regulation) (Somers Road North Area) (No. 9) Order, 1962

On the 10th day of July 1962, the Portsmouth City Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from waiting in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Somers Road North. The north side, between its junction with the east side of Besant Road and its junction with the west side of Fratton Road.

Fratton Grove.

(a) The south side between its junction with the east side of Vivash Road and its junction with the west side of Fratton Road.

(b) The north side between its junction with the east side of Vivash Road and a point 30 feet east of that junction.

Vivash Road. Between its junction with the south side of Somers Road North and its junction with the north side of Lucknow Street.

Lucknow Street

(a) The north side.

(b) the south side, between its junction with the east side of Somers Road North and a point 30 feet east of that junction.

(c) The south side, between its junction with the west side of Fratton Road, and a point 30 feet west of that junction.
