EXTINGUISHMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY *London County Council*

Metropolitan Borough of Bermondsey

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing
and Local Government, in exercise of the powers
conferred upon him by section 23 of the Town and
Country Planning Act, 1944, as incorporated with
the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, has
prepared in draft and proposes to make an Order
extinguishing the public rights of way over parts of
Llewellyn Street and Farncombe Street, in the Metro-
politan Borough of Bermondsey.

Copies of the draft Order and of the map relative
thereto showing the land over which the rights of
way proposed to be extinguished subsist may be in-
spected at the County Hall, Westminster Bridge,
London S.E.1, and at the Bermondsey Metropolitan
Borough Offices, Spa Road, London S.E.16, without
payment of fee during the usual office hours.

Any objection to this proposal must be made in
writing and addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of
Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London
S.W.1, before the 3rd day of November 1962.

The Minister is not, in all cases, required to cause
a local inquiry to be held. It is important, therefore,
that an objection should include a full statement in
writing of the grounds on which the objection is
made, as the objector may have no further oppor-
tunity to make such a statement.
