HEMEL HEMPSTEAD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Hemel Hempstead (Traffic Regulation No. 1) Order 1962

The Comporation of Hemel Hempstead propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 11960 the effect of which will be

- (il) Amend the existing unilateral waiting arrangements in Lawn Lane by extending the maximum period of waiting to sixty minutes instead of twenty period of waiting to sary infinites instead of twenty minutes as at present and to institute similar unilateral waiting arrangements in Marlowes both sides from a point approximately 15 yards north of the junction with (Combe Street to a point 47 yards south of the south corner of No. 3 Queensway a distance of approximately 380 yards but excluding a length of 65 yards lying between points 46 yards south and 16 yards north of the junction with Midland Road.
- (2) Restrict waiting to a period not exceeding sixty minutes in
 - (a) Marlowes from a point approximately 46 yards north of the junction with Waterhouse Street to a point 115 yards south of the junction with Combe Street but excluding (i) a length from a point 118 yards south of the junction with Tudor Hill to a point 115 yards north of that junction a distance (including the width of Tudor Hill) of 41 yards; (ii) a tength from a point 17 yards south of the junction with Bridge Street to a point 15 yards month of that junction a distance (including the width of Bridge Street) of 47 yards; (iii) a tength from a point 115 yards south of the junction with Hillfield Road to a point 32 yards north of that junction a distance (including the width of Hillfield Road) of 67 yards where waiting will be prohibited; (b) King Harry Street (East side only) from the footpath on the north side of the car park to a point 116 yards south of Hillfield Road; (c) Bridge Street (East section) both sides from a point 116 yards from the junction with Marlowes to a point 115 yards from the junction with Waterhouse Street.

- (3) Prohibit waiting in the following lengths of
 - Queensway (B.487) both sides, from a point approximately 26 yards west of the entrance to Gadebridge Park to the commencement of the lay-by on the south side 105 yards east of Alexandra Road;
 - Alexandra Road both sides, from the junction with ... Queensway for a distance of 115 yards from that junction;
 - Alexandra Road east side only, from a point ill5 yards from its junction with Queensway to its junction with Christchurch Road;
 - Midland Road both sides, from the junction with Marlowes for a distance of 19 yards from that junction;
 - Hillfield Road both sides, from the junction with iMarlowes to the east side of the entrance to the tiered car park, and thence on the south side only to the east side of the east entrance to the West Herts Hospital;

Tudor Hill both sides, from the junction with Marlowes to the junction with King Harry Street:

King Harry Street both sides, from a point 15 yards south of the junction with Tudor Hill to the footpath on the north side of the car park, and from the junction with Hillfield Road to a point 115 yards south of that junction;

King Harry Street on the west side from a point opposite the footpath on the north side of the car park to a point 15 yards south of the junction with Hillfield Road;

High Street both sides, from its junction with Queensway to the south end of St. Mary's Close; Marlowes (A.4146) both sides, from a point 115 yards south of the junction with Waterhouse Street to a point 46 yards north of that junction, a distance (including the width of Waterhouse Street) of 71 yards;

Marlowes (A.4146) both sides, from a point 18 yards south of the junction with Tudor Hill to a point 15 yards north of that junction, a distance (including the width of Tudor Hill) of 41 yards;

Marlowes (A.4146) both sides, from a point 17 yards south of the junction with Bridge Street to a point 15 yards north of that junction, a

distance (including the width of Bridge Street) of 47 yards;

Marlowes (A.4146) both sides, from a point 15 yards south of the junction with Hillfield Road to a point 32 yards nonth of that junction, a distance (including the width of Hillfield Road) of 67 yards;

Marlowes (A.4.146) both sides, from a point 15 yards south of the junction with Combe Street to a point 15 yards north of that junction, a distance including the width of Combe Street) of 40 yands;

Marlowes (A.4146) both sides, from a point 42 yards south of the junction with Midland Road yards south of the junction with ivilliand react to a point 16 yards north of the junction with Midland Road, a distance (including the width of Midland Road) of approximately 65 yards;

Marlowes (A.4146) from the junction with Queens way to a point approximately 47 yards south of the south corner of No. 3 Queensway, a distance of approximately 35 yards (both sides of the road);

Moor End Road both sides, from its junction with Waterhouse Street to its junction with Leighton Buzzard Road;

Waterhouse Street both sides from its junction with Marlowes to its junction with Combe Street, but

Marlowes to ats junction with Combe extreet, but excluding the Taxi rank on the west side; Bridge Street east section both sides, from its junction with Marlowes to a point 16½ yards west of that junction, and from its junction with Waterhouse Street to a point 15 yards east of that junction;

Bridge Street (west section) both sides, from its junction with Waterhouse Street westwards for the full length;

Combe Street both sides, from its junction with Marlowes to its junction with Leighton Buzzard Road:

- (4) Prohibit loading and unloading of vehicles in Marlowes from the junction with Waterhouse Street to the junction with Combe Street, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.
- (5) Restrict loading and unloading of vehicles in the following streets to a period not exceeding fiwenty manutes in any one hour between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive:

Lawn Lane (Uniflateral Parking area only)
Marlowes (Combe Street to Queensway)

Bridge Street

Hillfield Road (from Marlowes to east end of tiered car park)

Waterhouse Street Moor End Road

Combe Street

Queensway (from Park entrance to Layby on south side east of Alexandra Road)

Alexandra Road (from Queensway to Christchurch Road mainly east side)

Midland Road (from Marlowes to a point 19 yards

High Street (from Queensway to St. Mary's Close)

Where not otherwise stated it is proposed that the above prohibitions and restrictions shall apply between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on

Mondays to Saturdays both days inclusive.

Nothing in the proposed order will prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the restricted areas when acting upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or

- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle ;
- (b) where building operations, road repairs are

concerned;

(c) to enable the refuelling of a vehicle, or

(d) for the delivery or collection of postal packages
as defined in the Post Office Act, 1953.

A copy of the draft Order and a map showing the proposals may be examined at my office at the Town Hall, Hemel Hempstead during normal office hours. Objections to the proposal must be sent in writing to me by 31st August 1962.
