The Maidstone (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order, 1962

The Maidstone Borough Council propose to make an Order under sub-section (1) of section 81 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, sub-section (2) of section 11 of, and sub-section (1) of section 16 of the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to amend "The Maidstone (Off-Street Parking Places) Order, 1962" as follows:

Certain alterations in the wording of Articles 2 and 17 and the Schedule of that Order made at the suggestion of the Ministry of Transport for clarification and for procedural reasons, none of which affect the intention and operation of the Order.

The inclusion in Article 7 of the Order of a power to issue season tickets in respect of vehicles having more than two wheels, at the following rates, at such parking place or places as may be prescribed from time to time by the Council:

<i>Quarterly</i> ...	Not exceeding £19 10s. 0d.
<i>Monthly</i> ...	Not exceeding £6 10s. 0d.
<i>Weekly</i> ...	Not exceeding £1 10s. 0d.

The amendment of the Schedule of the Order by the addition thereto of the Schedule set out below.

The amendment of Article 7 of the Order so as to provide that charges will not be payable in respect of parking places numbered 14 and 15 in the Schedule set out below.

The amendment of Article 7 of the Order so as to provide that charges as set out in that Article and as now proposed to be amended in respect of season tickets may be made in respect of parking place numbered 16 in the Schedule set out below.
