## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

## STRETTFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Stretford (Chatsworth Road and Winchester Road) (Prohibition of Heavy Traffic) Order, 1961.*

unless requiring access to premises adjoining the roads.
