WAGES COUNCILS ACT, 1959

Retail Furnishing and Allied Trades Wages Council (Great Britain)

The Retail Furnishing and Allied Trades Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour proposals for (1) increasing the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Retail Furnishing and Allied Trades) Order, 1961 (Order R.F.A. (34)) as amended by the Wages Regulation (Retail Furnishing and Allied Trades) (Amendment) Order, 1962 (Order R.F.A. (36)) and requiring holidays to be allowed and holiday remuneration to be paid in accordance with that Order and (2) the revocation of Order R.F.A. (34) and Order R.F.A. (36).
