The London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (Lewisham) (No. 2) Regulations, 1962 (S.I. 1962/21118)

Under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, as amended, the Minister of Transport has made Regulations, coming into operation on 12th October 1962, which institute one-way traffic working in the following lengths of road in the Metropolitan Borough of Lewisham:

1. Montpelier Row, between Royal Parade and Montpelier Vale. From north to south.
2. Montpelier Vale. From Royal Parade towards Tranquil Vale.
3. Royal Parade. From south-west to north-east.
4. Tranquil Vale, between Montpelier Vale and Royal Parade. From south-east to north-west.
5. All Saints Drive, between its south-western junction with Royal Parade and Montpelier Vale and a point 200 feet north-west of that junction. From south-east to north-west.
