

At the Court at Balmoral, the 2nd day of October 1962.

PRESENT,

The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas there was this day read at the Board a Memorial from the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, dated the 21st day of September 1962 (S.D. 7368/61), in the words following, viz.:

"Whereas by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act, 1865, it is enacted, *inter alia*, that all pay, pensions or other allowances in the nature thereof payable in respect of services in Your Majesty's Naval or Marine Force to a person being or having been an Officer, Seaman or Marine therein shall be paid in such manner and subject to such

restrictions, conditions and provisions as are from time to time directed by Order in Council;

"And whereas Orders in Council dated the 12th day of August 1907, the 14th day of October 1947, the 10th day of March 1952 and the 25th day of June 1958, sanctioned (among other things) the titles for ratings in the Communication Branch of the Royal Navy;

"And whereas we consider that the titles so sanctioned could, in the light of changing conditions and duties, with advantage be changed as shown in the annexed Schedule;

"We beg humbly to recommend that Your Majesty may be graciously pleased by Your Order in Council to sanction the new titles in the annexed Schedule for these ratings.

"The Lords Commissioners of Your Majesty's Treasury have been informed of these proposals.
