TREASURY

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under sections 1, 2 and 13 of the Import Duties Act, 1958, viz.: The Import Duties (General) (No. 12) Order, 1962.

This Order reduces as from 31st October 1962:

- (1) the full rate of import duty (and proportionately the Commonwealth preferential rate) on certain goods in accordance with the undertakings given by the United Kingdom at Geneva and set out in the July 1962 Protocol to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade;
- (2) the rates of import duty on the goods to which the E.F.T.A. Convention applies.

The E.F.T.A. reduction is of one sixth of the current Convention rates of duty except in those cases where the rate is specially reduced under Article 3 (3) and (4) and in certain cases where a concession made in G.A.T.T. undertakings has resulted in new or amended sub-headings in the Customs Tariff.

Schedule 1 to the Order sets out the headings and sub-headings where, under the G.A.T.T. undertakings, a change in the full or Commonwealth rate of duty only is involved.

Schedule 2 sets out the headings and sub-headings with the E.F.T.A. rates of duty which cannot now be conveniently expressed as a fraction of the full rate in the Schedule to the Import Duties (General) (No. 3) Order, 1961.

Schedule 3 sets out the sub-headings where particular E.F.T.A. rates of duty apply.

Schedule 4 sets out the sub-headings where, consequent upon the G.A.T.T. undertakings, amendment of the text as well as of the rates of duty is involved.

The Order comes into operation on the 31st October 1962, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1962, No. 2240.
