*The Traffic Signs (Speed Limits) Regulations and General Directions, 1962 (S.I. 1962/2388)*

Under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, as amended by the Road Traffic Act, 1962, the Secretary of State and the Minister of Transport have jointly made Regulations, which prescribe traffic signs for speed limits, and have severally given general directions, which relate to the erection of those signs. The instrument came into force on 1st November 1962.

*The London Traffic (Prohibition of Waiting) (Buckland, Surrey) Regulations, 1962 (S.I. 1962/2390)*

Under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, as amended, the Minister of Transport has made Regulations, coming into operation on 15th November 1962, which prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting of vehicles at all times on the north side of the Maidstone—Guildford Road (A.25), Buckland, between points 190 yards and 540 yards east of the eastern flank wall of the "Jolly Farmers" Public House.

*The London Traffic (Prohibition of Driving) (Orpington) Regulations, 1962 (S.I. 1962/2395)*

*The London Traffic (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 13) Regulations, 1962 (S.I. 1962/2394)*

Under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, as amended, the Minister of Transport has made Regulations, coming into operation on 19th November 1962, which restrict the speed of vehicles to 40 m.p.h. on the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.
