TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS, 1944 AND 1947

Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way City of Plymouth

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government, in exercise of powers conferred upon him by section 23 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1944, as incorporated with
